Welcome to the first edition of the quarterly Arms of Love Foundation newsletter!

In October 2009, Arms of Love Foundation Indonesia was born! Located in Bali, Arms of Love Foundation exists to bring hope to a hurting world. Through a number of different projects (outlined in the newsletter) we aim to reach out to people in need and help them to be the best that they can be! Whether it's by sponsoring a young person to go to school or university, or by teaching single mothers how to sew so that they can start their own business and generate income for their families, we have a heart to see people cared for, trained, educated and equipped to face today's world. Arms of Love is a Christian based foundation founded by Pastor Wayan and Gayle Dwije as the social arm of C3 Church Bali.

Child Development Project

Our Child Development Project is what gave us a desire to start the Arms of Love Foundation! It has been operating for over two years now (even before the foundation officially started!) and partners together with Compassion International to see under-privileged children in between the ages of three-11 sponsored. 25 more children have just been added to the



project bringing the total to 150! We are overwhelmed at the testimonies from the children and their families about how their lives have been impacted. The kids are now able to go to school, have regular health checkups, learn english and have a full healthy meal once a week. They also now have the opportunity to learn music, participate in sports, do computer classes, art classes, hip hop classes and a photography course is soon to come! Although the children are sponsored individually through Compassion International, this money does not cover the cost of running the project. It is the Arms of Love Foundation that sponsors the project which the children attend 4 times a week where they are able to do the above things!

Community Projects



Adopting urban slum areas and villages that are in poverty by bringing light and hope through community development is our goal through community projects. We are currently focusing on one slum area to clean out all rubbish and put bins in that will be emptied on a regular basis. We are also working towards clean water, house renovations and providing mattresses for each family.

Micro-Enterprise Projects



In 2009 we started a women's sewing project for the mum's of the children in our child development project. Ten mum's were asked to join the sewing project and they spent three afternoons a week for ten weeks learning how to sew from a professional. They came out with great new skills, new friendships and new opportunities for generating income for their families. We will be holding this course again in a couple of months time .

House of Hope

We are excited to announce that in April this year the House of Hope was officially opened by Terry Muller, a representative of our main sponsor of the house, Suncity Christian Centre in Geraldton, Western Australia. The House of Hope is a safe place where women from 15yrs+ can come if they need accommodation, counseling and moral support. They can also learn life skills and receive academic help if needed. The accommodation currently can house four women mid - long term (three - 18 months) and three women short term (one day- three months). Some examples of women we house are young women saved from child trafficking, single pregnant girls, women fleeing domestic violence, sexual abuse & discrimination.



Medical Clinic

Our goal for the Medical Clinic is to provide an affordable medical service for the local community and a free service to those who are in poverty. We are also in the process of building a team that visits slum areas regularly to do health checkups. We have just recently taken a medical team into a slum area and were able to help over 50 people in just a couple of hours by giving them health checkups, health advice and basic medicine according to their needs.
